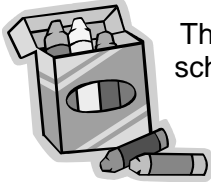

Visit www.hopeumc.org and click on the Online Offering link to make your tithes and offerings securely—whenever it's convenient for you!
